


Recognition of talent

Recognition of talent

"Ordinary" QuarkNet teachers do extraordinary things

- Leadership develops at
 - Local centers
 - National-level meetings and events
- Staff observe teacher interactions in these settings, looking for appropriate talent and interest



Developing Leadership

Staff, Mentors, Lead Teachers, Fellows, Colleagues:

- Model leadership, including reinforcing QuarkNet norms at every meeting
- Create or enhance leadership opportunities
- Learn from each other
- Bring new content and methods to centers and teachers



Avenues

Lead Teachers - 1 or 2 per center

- Build center relationships
 - Mentors
 - Other teachers and lead teachers
 - Institution
 - Outside center
- Determine roles based on relationships, needs





Avenues

Lead Teachers

- Support
 - Lead Teacher Camps
- Examples of leadership roles
 - Recruitment of new teachers
 - Workshop design
 - Organizational nuts and bolts





Avenues

Fellows - a few to 15 per fellows group

- Work as team and in smaller units
- Roles in common
 - Model QuarkNet methods to other teachers
 - Develop expertise in fellows group area
- Individual or small group roles
 - Facilitate workshops
 - Develop workshops or related materials, activities



Avenues

Fellows

- Support
 - Regular online meetings
 - Fellows Camps
 - Shadow workshop facilitators
 - Collaboration with staff and each other
