Many QN represented schools have very similar names/locations

# **QUARKNET Broadening Participation**

## **School-wide Student Demographics**

Across centers considerable variation

- Urban, rural, and suburban schools
- Most often public schools; a few private schools
- Student enrollment size: varied small to large
- Well-balanced by gener of students
- Students eligible for free/reduced lunch
- Student ethnicity
