- The <u>W2D2 Schedule of Videoconferences</u> is now available! It lists cities by location and time along with moderators. **Teachers and moderators both: please check to be sure the schedule works for you and, if there is any problem, contact me as soon as you can.**
- It is always best to test your videoconference connection, so we will have Zoom and Google Meet tests next week on Mon 29 Nov. The times are listed under <u>Videoconference Tests</u> in the Videocons page. Zoom tests are on the <u>W2D2 Zoom channel</u>. Google Meet tests are on the <u>W2D2 GM channel</u>. For security, please do not give this information out to others. <u>Exception</u>: give the information to your students when they need it if they are connecting to your scheduled W2D2 videocon remotely. Please only use these channels according to the Schedule of Videoconferences or for scheduled videocon tests.
