Some skills will be made obsolete by AI, but the **main goals** we have **in universities** is that ***you learn how to learn*** and ***how to think***

- ~ Understanding the **fundamentals** seems to **pay off** even in the **AI era**
- ~ For instance, **AI models** are **very good at coding**
- ~ **"Vibe-coding"**: simply tell the **AI** in **English** what you **want coded**
  - Allows **people without coding background** to write pretty **sophisticated apps, websites**
- ~ Initially thought **AI** would **reduce differences in coding ability**
